

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF INFORMATION FROM NON-CITIZENS FORM

International applicants must provide Georgia Institute of Technology with information needed to secure a visa. You must complete the following form and return it with your other supporting documents. You must also provide certified documentation indicating that you have funding sufficient to cover your first year of study including living expenses for yourself and any dependents.

Below are tables giving you the estimated costs for tuition and fees, books and supplies, insurance, and living expenses. Locate the program to which you are applying and use the figures in the corresponding table to determine how much funding you must be able to guarantee.

**All programs are considered twelve month programs except the following:**

**Nine Month Programs:** Architecture (Ph.D. only), Bioinformatics, City & Regional Planning, Digital Media, Economics, Human Computer Interaction, Human Centered Computing, History and Sociology of Technology and Science, Industrial Design, Information Design Technology, Information Security, International Affairs, Master of Business Administration, Psychology, Public Policy, Quantitative Computational Finance
